PHARMACY FIRST SERVICE

As of 31 January 2024, community pharmacies can offer treatment for seven common conditions without patients needing to see a GP as part of a major transformation in the way the NHS delivers care. These conditions are:

- sinusitis (ages 12+)
- sore throat (ages 5+)
- acute otitis media/ear ache (ages 1-17)
- infected insect bite (ages 1+)
- impetigo (ages 1+)
- shingles (ages 18+)
- uncomplicated urinary tract infections in women (ages 16-64, not suitable if recurring)

*Please note that the pharmacy first service is not suitable if you are pregnant

If you or your child has one of these issues, please contact your local pharmacy and they will advise on how is best to help you.

COVID-19 SPRING VACCINATION PROGRAMME

The NHS will contact you if your NHS record suggests you may be eligible for a seasonal spring COVID-19 vaccine. You may be offered a spring COVID-19 vaccine from April 2024 if you:

- are aged 75 years old or over
- live in a care home for older adults
- are aged 6 months old or over and have a weakened immune system

Clinics are going to be held at Captain French Surgery starting end of April, and run by our Kendal Primary Care Network.

You can book your appointment via the National Booking system (search 'book covid vaccine' in your search engine to find the NHS website) or by calling 119.





BECOME A DISPENSING PATIENT!

Did you know that if you live more than 1 mile away from a pharmacy that you are eligible to be a dispensing patient? This means you can:

- Collect your medication directly from Helme Chase there's no need to go to a Pharmacy.
- Take advantage of our Automatic Repeat Dispensing Scheme no need to order your prescription.
- Have your medication delivered by the practice to your home, free of charge
 - Our delivery drivers will deliver your medication straight to your door.

- No need to order we will arrange to deliver your medication every 4 weeks. Contact our dispensary today to enquire if you are eligible for this service.
